HWBOT World Tour Stops at Campus Party Sao Paulo, Brazil

HWBOT Invites Brazilian Ambient and Extreme Overclockers to Learn and Compete in the Latin American Stop of the HWBOT World Tour 2017

January 25, 2017, Taipei, Taiwan - HWBOT, an organization regulating international Overclocking competitions and rankings, today officially announces the second stop of the HWBOT World Tour 2017. In Sao Paulo, Brazil, during the first week of February, HWBOT hosts an overclocking workshop and the Latin American qualifier of the Overclocking World Championship at Campus Party.



“We look forward to returning to Sao Paulo for the Latin American leg of the World Tour 2017, a city that brings back fond memories,” commented Pieter-Jan Plaisier, Director at HWBOT. “Campus Party brings together the perfect audience for overclocking with students, technology enthusiasts and gamers all in one location. The Brazilian passion is energizing and people are eager to find out more about Overclocking.”

Overclocking World Championship 2017 Qualifier

Each stop of the tour includes an Overclocking World Championship Qualifier contest where the winner gets to secure a place in the World Championship 2017 Final at the end of the year. The Qualifier contest winner will walk away with a trophy and a ticket to the Final.



February 3rd: Qualification Day

On the fourth day of the HWBOT World Tour – Sao Paulo 2017 event, Brazil's most renowned and respected Overclockers will battle it out across three benchmarks in just three hours. The top four will be invited to return for the Semi-Finals on the following day.

- Three benchmarks in three hours
- Kaby Lake CPUs provided by Intel and HWBOT
- Power Supplies provided by Seasonic

February 4th: Semi-Finals and Final

Day five of the HWBOT World Tour - Sao Paulo 2017 event will see the top four overclockers compete in a unique contest format that pits contestants against each other in a 1v1 format. Benchmarks will be randomly drawn from a pool of six options. Each overclocker will possess one veto which can be used strategically to avoid an unfavorable benchmark being selected.
